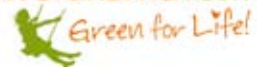

Purpose

- Promote the industry to the general public
- Recognize excellence within the industry
- Provide advertising and marketing opportunities
- Encourage landscape contractors to continue their efforts to raise the industry's image by consistent use of quality materials and competent workmanship

Rules

This provincial program is exclusive to Landscape New Brunswick members. LNB member companies may enter any project completed by their company from any time past, and may enter the same project every other year, provided new photos are taken and a new description made. Once a project has successfully won an award, it cannot be reentered. Companies can submit more than one entry per category.

Jury and Judging

A jury of distinguished professionals in the fields of landscape design, education and horticulture will evaluate entries based on the materials (both plant and construction), design, completeness of installation, workmanship and horticultural correctness in landscape installation and maintenance using only the images, plans and descriptions submitted with each entry.

Construction:

- Best Residential Construction Project Over \$25,000
- Best Residential Construction Project Under \$25,000
- Best Commercial Construction Project

Specialty Awards

- Water Feature
- Pavers
- Lighting
- Design only
- Unique Landscape Feature

Maintenance:

- Best Residential Lawn and Garden Maintenance: Any Size
- Best Commercial Lawn and Garden Maintenance: Any Size

Awards of Landscape Excellence Program *Entry Form: Construction and Specialty Awards*

Guidelines For Entering

1. Any one job can be entered in multiple categories. For example, a project entered in the Construction Over \$25,000, may also have its components entered in the specialty categories (design, water feature, lighting, and or specialty feature).
2. Each company may enter as many jobs per category as they like.
3. Construction jobs do not need to be completed during the year they are entered in the awards program. Any job can be entered every other year until it wins. New pictures and updated descriptions are required and must be submitted.
4. Entrant assumes the responsibility for copyrights, photographic fees and client permission for further use of images by LNB for public relations purposes. LNB is not responsible for the pictures selected or any edited copy used from the press package sent to the media. Entries become the property of LNB and may be used for publication or for any other purpose the Association deems appropriate.
5. The news release on winning entrants will be available after the awards have been announced.
6. Photography
This is not a photography contest; however, the judges feel the following points will be helpful:
 - a) Before, during and after pictures taken from the same vantage point are useful.
 - b) The judges will determine the quality of materials (both plant and construction), design, completeness of installation, workmanship, maintenance and horticultural correctness in landscape installation using only the images plans and descriptions submitted with each entry.
 - c) The judges find that overhead shots taken from a normal vantage point (i.e. from a deck, upstairs window etc.) are helpful.
 - d) Be choosy about the photos you enter. Avoid dark, dirty, light or out of focus images.
 - e) A written description for each photo is helpful as well
4. Explanation of the judging process:
 - a) The judges decisions are based on the image presentation, plan and written description of each entry.
 - b) The judge's decision is final.
